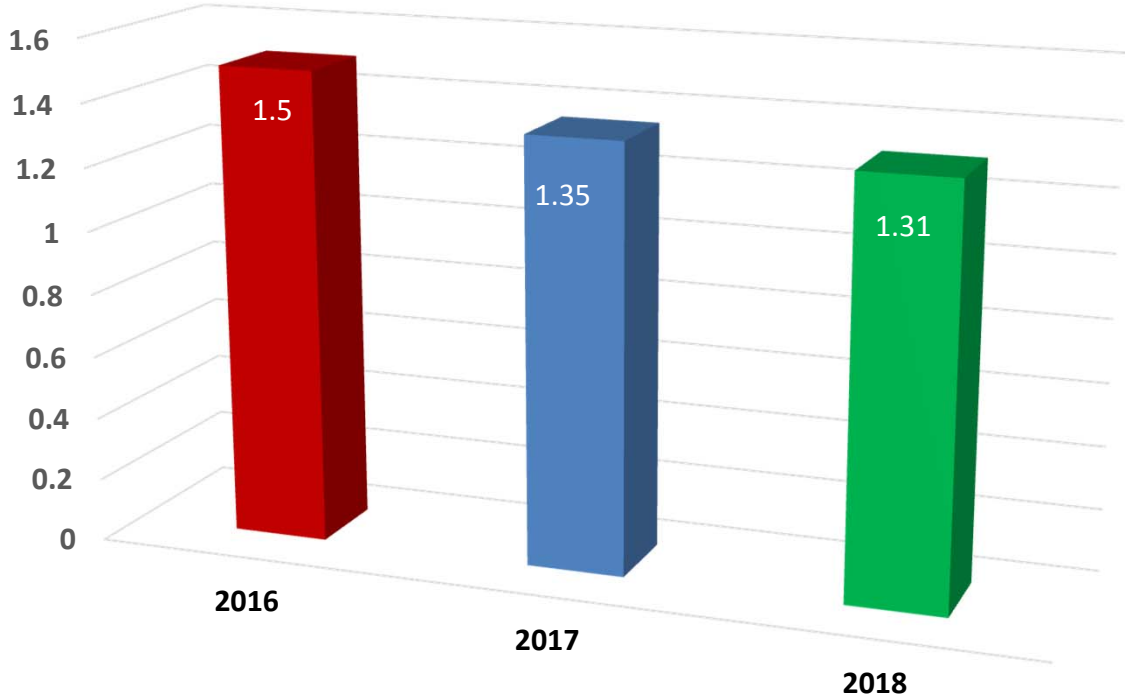
Safety Department Mission Statement

All data YTD November



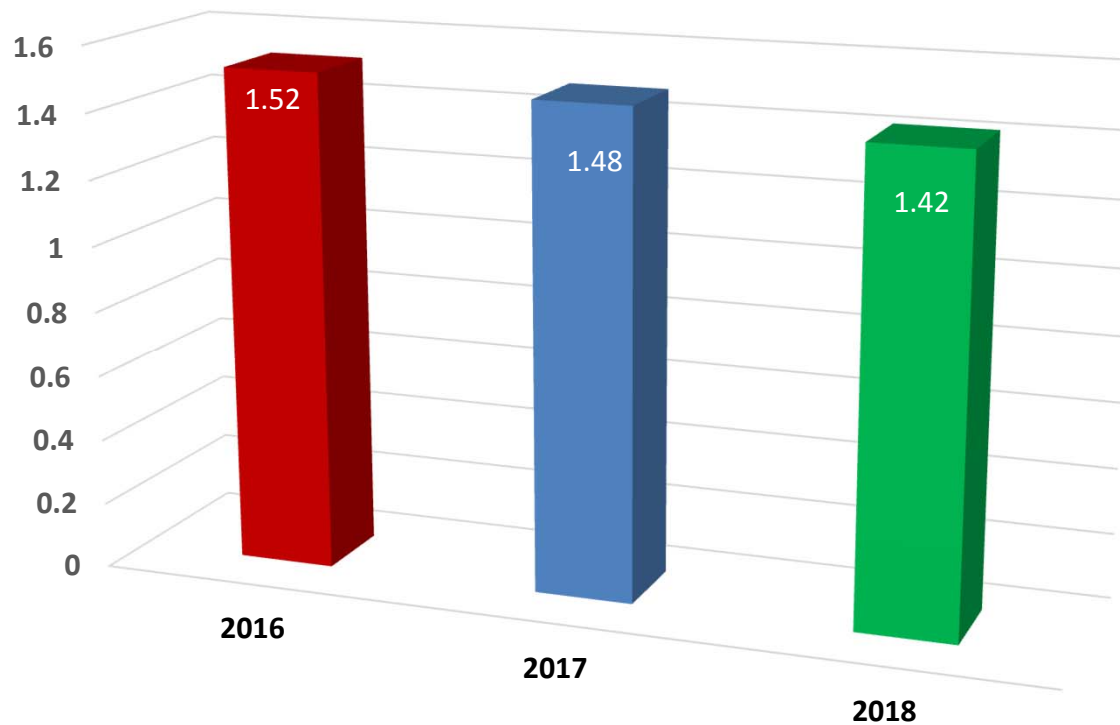

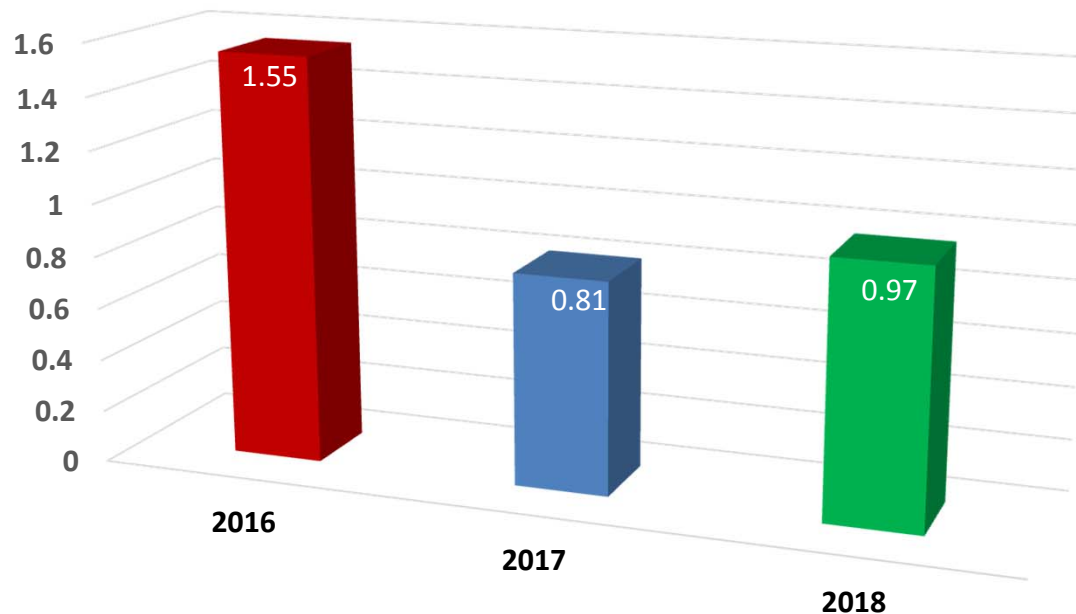

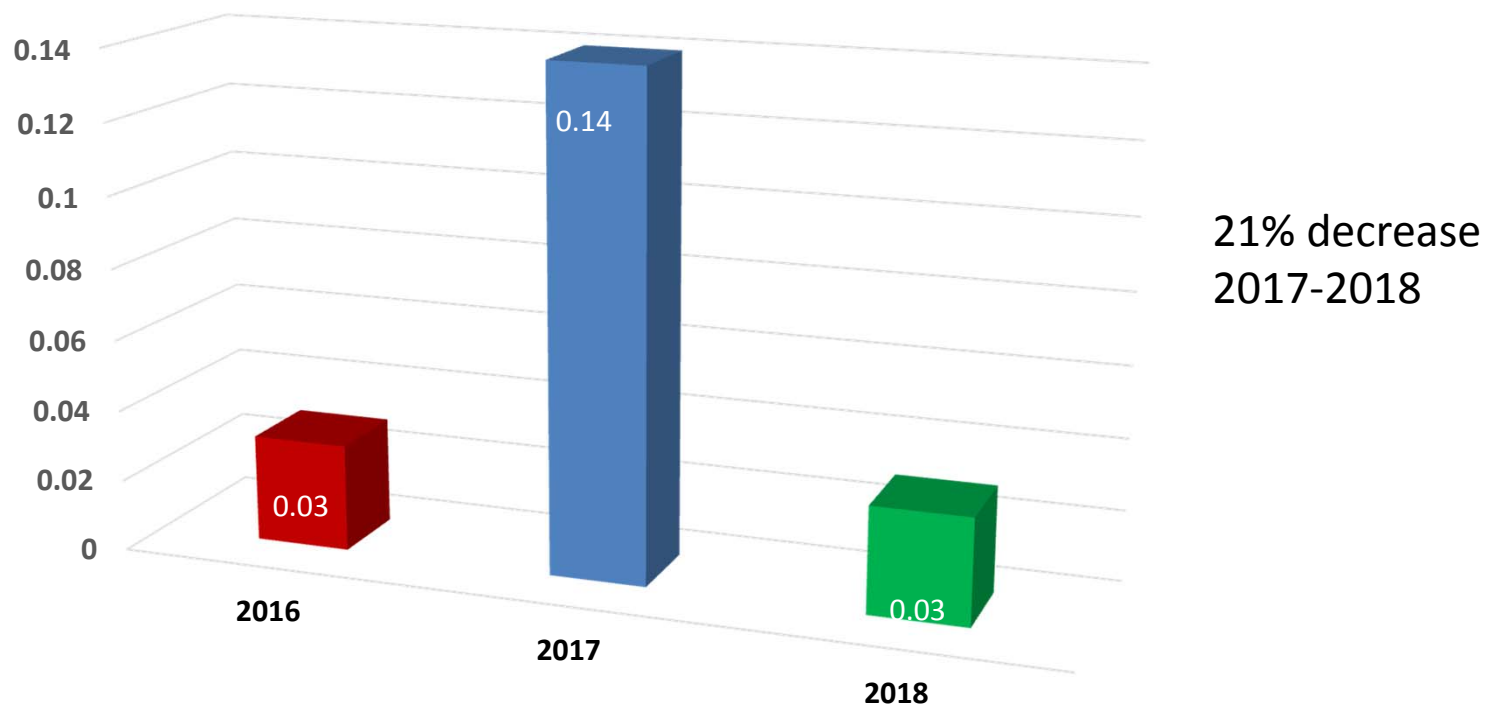

2016 – 2018 per 100,000 Miles Driven

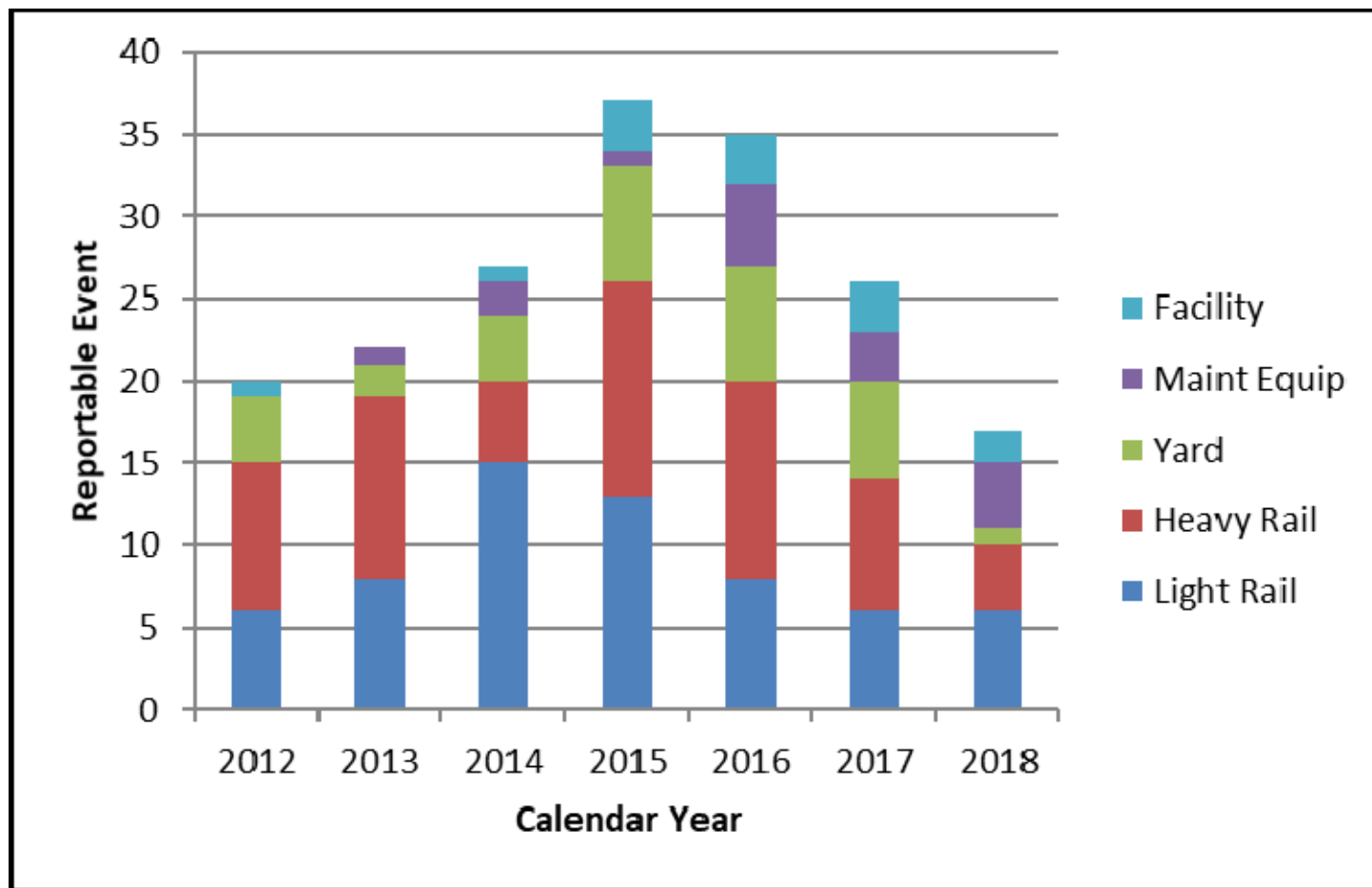

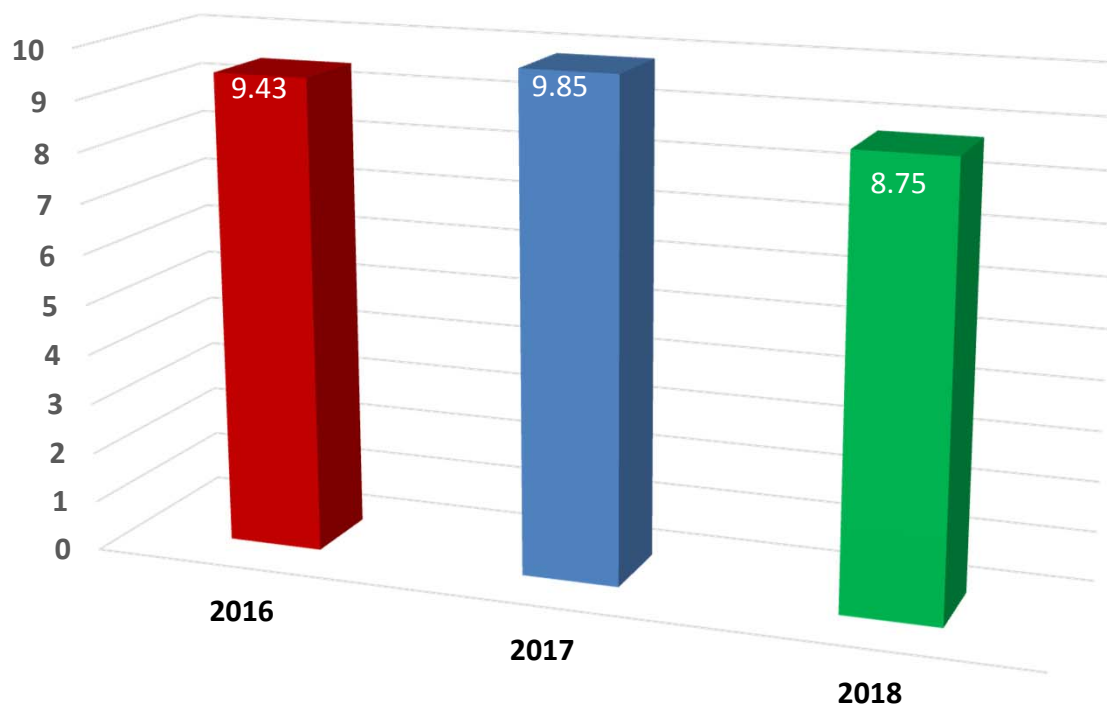


Events Broken Down by Year and Location
