# History

- Provided operating funds to the city of Brunswick since 1988
- Medina County Public Transit (MCPT) began absorbing the City of Brunswick's service in 2014. Merger completed 2016
- GCRTA has provided operating funds for capital funds to MCPT since 2014
- FTA has approved this process for each agreement

# Purpose of Agreement

- Apply for Medina County Public Transit grant funds
- Transfer GCRTA operating funds to MCPT in exchange for the capital funds (less \$54,000 for paying a portion of the Route 251 Flyer)
- Reason: MCPT does not have enough capital needs to utilize all of the funds and is need of operating funds

# Amount

- \$681,047
  - 2018 Section 5339 funds \$17,941
  - 2019 Section 5339 funds \$88,553
  - 2018 Section 5307 funds \$39,782
  - 2019 Section 5307 funds \$534,771

## Recommendation

Staff requests that the Operational Planning & Infrastructure Committee recommend this provision to the Board of Trustees for approval. If this is not approved the unused grant funds could be reallocated outside the Cleveland Urbanized Area.
