Intergovernmental Student Transportation Agreement – Cleveland Metropolitan School District (CMSD)

Overview

- CMSD wishes to make public transportation available to its enrolled students Grades 6-12
- The term of the agreement is from July 18, 2019 – June 19, 2020. Since the school year has started, the cards have already been provided to CMSD.
- For internal control purposes, GCRTA provides magnetic stripe farebox compatible picture card ID passes with certain blackout dates around school holidays.

Highlights of Terms

- 16,000 fare-cards (down from 18,000 cards last year)
- Total value of agreement of \$4,308,000.
- On a per card basis, last school year was priced at \$254.22. Current agreement is based on \$269.24.
- Overall agreement is similar to prior year and will require a lump sum payment to GCRTA by October 31, 2019.
- Any tickets provided for services over and above will be at \$1.75/ride.

Recommendation

- Staff requests that the Operational Planning & Infrastructure Committee recommend to the Board of Trustees the approval of the Intergovernmental Student Transportation Agreement with CMSD for the 2019-20 school year, and ratification of the CEO's action to provide the passes to CMSD prior to the beginning of the school year.
