Ridership Report – June 2023

Summary

- Ridership continued to recover from the COVID-19 pandemic and resulting shutdowns
- System ridership in June 2023 was 1.8 million, representing 13% more riders than in June 2022
 - Average fixed route weekday was 12% higher¹
 - Average fixed route Saturday was 15% higher¹
 - Average fixed route Sunday was 15% higher¹



Bus (MB)

Bus ridership in June 2023 was 15% higher than in June 2022

- Average weekday was 15% higher¹
- Average Saturday was 16% higher¹
- Average Sunday was 17% higher¹



Red Line (HR)

Red Line ridership in June 2023 was 15% higher than in June 2022

- Average weekday was 12% higher¹
- Average Saturday was 30% higher¹
- Average Sunday was 22% higher¹



Light Rail (LR)

Light Rail ridership in June 2023 was 17% lower than in June 2022

- Average weekday was 19% lower¹
- Average Saturday was 2% higher¹
- Average Sunday was 24% lower¹



HealthLine (RB)

HealthLine ridership in June 2023 was 1% higher than in June 2022

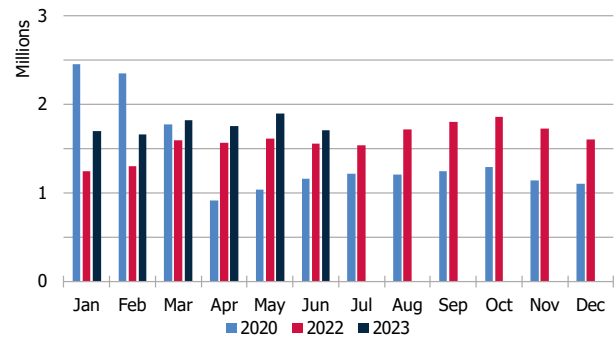
- Average weekday was 1% higher¹
- Average Saturday was 5% lower¹
- Average Sunday was 9% higher¹



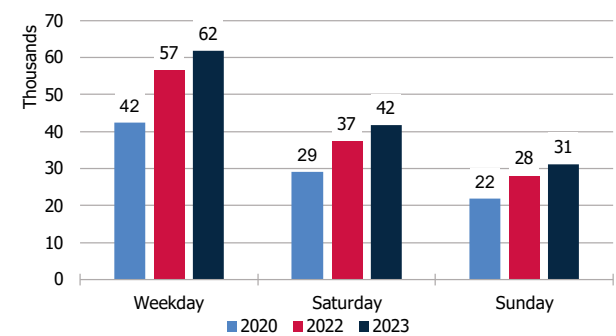
Paratransit (DR)

Paratransit ridership in June 2023 was 15% higher than in June 2022

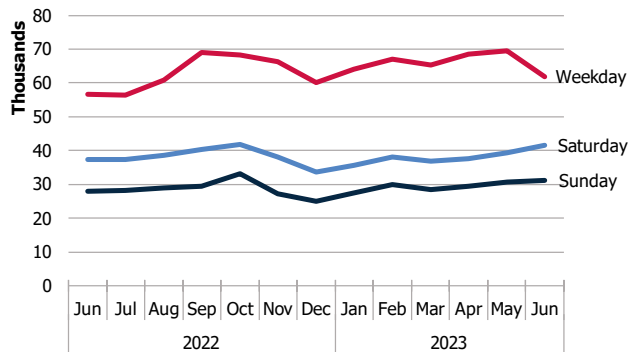
System Ridership by Month



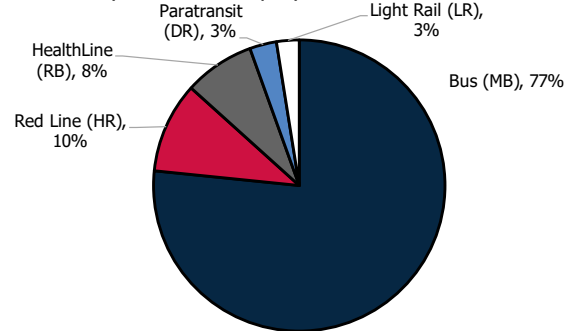
June Avg. Ridership by Day Type (no Paratransit)
